A few tips to make your stay at Roskhill House an enjoyable one:

Mobile phone reception is very poor within the house, but if you take a short walk to the main road or up the lane to the bridge you will get a good signal.

To make calls, we also recommend using WhatsApp. It's a good way to reach us too – (+44) 7958 411530.

Wi-fi is generally more reliable (though island weather can create some issues). Internet is available throughout the house. Just log on to Roskhill House Guests and add the password: Roskhill2025

We feel privileged to live in such a beautiful place and strive to reduce the impact we make on the environment. We try to minimise the use of unnecessary cleaning products and to reduce waste and water usage.

We follow "Visit Scotland" recommendations and will fully clean the rooms and towels every four days. We will do a daily refresh, though. We recycle as much as possible including paper, cardboard, aluminium cans, and glass and plastic bottles. Do place such items in the recycling bins in your rooms.

Electric and hybrid car owners can recharge their vehicles on site, for an additional fee of £0.40 per k/w. Do ask for more information.

Our commitment to sustainability extends to our 100% vegetarian and vegan breakfasts, which are served between **08:00 - 09:00** every morning in our dining room.

Skye boasts a great variety of excellent restaurants, with several popular options located nearby. From fresh home cooking to Michelin starred fine dining, there's something for everyone. Did you know that in Old Norse, Roskhill is thought to mean 'Horse Gully', from "Hross" and "Gil" – perhaps inspired by the mythical water horses that previously roamed through Roskhill?

Within your room you will find a selection of treats, including exceptional teas from Shibui and freshly ground coffee from our favourite independent coffee shop, Birch in Portree. Fridges are stocked with oat milk and cow's milk as well as filtered tap water. Many of the local products are also available to purchase as gifts from our guest snug on the ground floor. Midge spray can also be purchased here. It could be the best buy of your holiday.

In the snug you will also find our "honesty bar" – perfect for a pre-dinner aperitif or a night-cap. Here we showcase whisky from across Scotland as well as beers, soft drinks, spirits, and excellent wines. We have a small selection of snacks available to purchase. Just note down what you have taken, so that we can charge this to your room.

We offer a simple laundry service, subject to availability – we charge £8 to wash and dry a single load. You'll find an empty laundry bag in your wardrobe.
